1. CALL TO ORDER AND WELCOME GUESTS

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m.

2. APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS

A. MINUTES OF THE REGULAR

Donnie Marshall made a motion to approve the minutes from the September 16, 2022. Kevin Cook seconded the motion. The motion unanimously carried.

B. FINANCIAL REPORT

Anita Treadway gave her report.

Kevin Cook made a motion to approve the financial report. Donnie Marshall seconded the motion. The motion unanimously carried.

C. PAYMENT OF BILLS

Kevin Cook asked questions about out of district fees. A question about Steve Gill's right to have a tap was made since this is out of district. The district has been paying tax on the Home Depot account that is Precision's account. Precision needs to take a tax-exempt form with them when they get supplies for Waterwood MUD. Kevin Cook made a motion to approve the payment the bills, subject to Tony getting information on the Precision invoice. Donnie Marshall seconded the motion. The motion unanimously carried.

D. TAX COLLECTORS REPORT

Anita Treadway gave the report.

Kevin Cook made a motion to accept the Tax Collector Report. Donnie Marshall seconded the motion. The motion unanimously carried.

3. DIRECTOR MATTERS

A. Discuss the Budget

Karon Murff gave the budget report. Kevin Cook motioned to accept the budget. He suggested to reduce the user fee and bring the net income to 0. Donnie Marshall seconded the motion. The motion unanimously carried. Karon will send an updated budget to MUD, WIA and John Kuhl.

B. Discussion of customer water bills and possible reduction

A motion to allow Precision Utility to approve a one-time adjustment of the customers who requested the following accounts:

- 1. Mindy Ferguson requested an adjustment because of a broken sprinkler system. Kevin Cook moved not to normalize unless the customer comes to the Board with more information. Donnie Marshall seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
- 2. Fred Grona said that his last bill had been extremely high (\$767). Normal bill runs \$80.00. JJ checked the meter reading, and it was correct. Kevin Cook asked if the meter had been calibrated and would like for JJ to test it. Kevin Cook made a motion to hold off until the meter is checked. Donnie Marshall seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Kevin Cook said to check with the Board BEFORE connecting any taps on FM 980.

D. Authorize appropriate action

There needs to be a list made of the valves in order to be able to isolate areas when there are leaks. Also, maintenance needs to be done on all the valves.

A. Receive general report – Precision Utility

Tony Bonaventure gave the maintenance and operation report.

There was discussion about the pump rental for the Attwood Lift station. (the cost is \$3,330.65 a month) Kevin Cook said he knows a rental company that the MUD district may be able to get a better price with.

B. Authorize appropriate action

The Board authorized Precision Utility to recommit to collecting the accounts that are delinquent. Donnie Marshall made a motion for Precision Utility to start collecting delinquent accounts. Kevin Cook seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

The clean up of metal at the sewer plant was discussed. A motion to have it cleaned up was made by Kevin Cook and seconded by Donnie Marshall. The motion carried unanimously.
